

Sponsor Honey



I'm a Common Squirrel Monkey called Honey. I was truly an 'International Primate Rescue' – kept illegally as a 'pet' in Israel, I was rescued in 2005 while I was still just an infant and flown to the safety of the sanctuary. I live with another squirrel monkey, my best friend Gillie.

Sponsor Papi

I'm Papilon – Papi for short – and I was also an 'International Primate Rescue'. I'm a Mona Monkey and I was stolen from the wild in the West Indies – when my parents were killed. This has made me very wary – I can be affectionate one minute then aggressive the next.



So I was taken to Hungary Zoo but people make me so agitated I never settled in public view. I'm doing much better now in the quiet of the sanctuary.

Sponsor a Monkey with International Primate Rescue UK (IPR UK)

IPR UK was established to relieve the suffering of non-human primates in any part of the world that are in need of care and attention and in particular to rescue and provide care and treatment for such primates that are unwanted, abandoned, neglected or ill-treated.

We support international work principally through a dedicated sanctuary, the first of its kind in South Africa, which opened at Polokwane in 1996 when it received its first monkey, an eight-month old Common Marmoset named Cheeky. In December 2001 the sanctuary was approached to help rescue a badly abused Patas Monkey in Israel, and Iris became its first International Primate Rescue.

It costs £300 a year to support each monkey at the sanctuary. Such is the demand that 20 hectares of land – at an initial cost of £30,000 – are now required to accommodate a future total of 200 primates. Vets' bills alone are £1,200 a month. In addition the sanctuary offers some 15 volunteering places, typically to students, every year.

Honey is just one of 80 small primates – some little bigger than your hand – cared for at International Primate Rescue's sanctuary in South Africa. From £5 a month you can help provide one or more of them with a lifetime of care.

Many were illegal pets. These pocket-size primates look so cute and friendly, but they behave like big primates, humans included. At adolescence they're like the worst of teenagers; aggressive and impossible to control.

Heartless owners abandon them – they're thrown out of cars, chucked into rivers or anonymously dumped overnight at the sanctuary, traumatised and sick through bad diet. They've never known life in a wild troupe, cannot be rehabilitated and require human care for the rest of their lives – maybe 12 or more years.

On arrival at the sanctuary, after a veterinary check and inoculations against disease, they go on a natural diet of fresh fruit and cereals. Once strong enough, the males are given vasectomies.

We also have to find companions – often a bit of trial and error. Although primates aren't naturally solitary, they take time to make friends. But with a roof over their heads, food in their bellies, good health and loving company, they enjoy long contented lives.
